What Help Do You Provide?

We provide ongoing support, during your pregnancy and after! During your pregnancy, we will be assisting you with every aspect of your adoption journey, providing counseling services, case management, adoption education, transportation, a cell phone, food and clothing assistance, possibly housing and so much more! After you deliver, you will continue to receive support. After delivery and placement, you will be able to receive continued support through the Donna K. Evans Foundation, which is our adoption aftercare program. The Donna K. Evans Foundation was developed to help our birth mothers continue their life journey, offering support such as group counseling, job searching, educational opportunities, clothing, long-term housing assistance, and much more.

What is the First Step?

We'll answer your questions and schedule an appointment for you with one of our adoption specialists. *All services for women considering adoption are free!* We provide transportation (*if needed*) to our office located in Phoenix, off the I-17 Access Road and Northern. We can meet with you the same day, night, or weekend.

Do I need to bring anything to the appointment?

An ID if you have one and any medical records pertaining to your pregnancy if you have any. Neither of these are required to make an appointment.

What happens at the appointment?

You learn about us and we get to learn about you! We'll answer your questions and explain the adoption process in detail, including the required adoption paperwork. We will begin the intake process at the same appointment if you are ready to begin.

What does the intake process look like?

An adoption specialist will talk with you about what you want your adoption journey to look like, what type of adoption you would like, and then gather information from you so we can learn more about you. We believe in emotional, financial, mental, and physical assistance for you during your adoption journey. We will discuss your financial situation and see how we can help! Depending on your situation we may be able to help with: immediate housing, a cell phone, utilities, transportation, clothing medical bills and food. We do help you in filling out the necessary paperwork.
